
SWISS EMMAUS LEPROSY RELIEF WORK - INDIA

Suneetha, 15 years old, lives with her mother Mrs. Parvathi and father Mr. Asappa. They are resident's of Deva Nagar Leprosy colony located in Dicuhpally of Nizamabad Dist of Andhra Pradesh. Suneetha's both the parents are affected by leprosy. They were cured of leprosy by taking MDT treatment with the help of "GRETNALTES" (a project of Swiss Emmaus Leprosy Relief Work India) in Tenali, Andhra Pradesh.



Suneetha's parents wanted to give good education to their daughter. They approached GRETNALTES an integrated school. GRETNALTES provides free

education to children born to people affected by and integrates them in order to help reduce stigma. result, Suneetha was admitted in the school run by GRETNALTES. She was provided free education, free food, free uniform, free books, and most importantly the nuture and guidance. She was average in studies, but with the encouragement and help she received from her teachers. she started to perform well.



Eenadu – Guntur – Friday 16th May, 2014, Ch.Suneetha who secured the highest 10/10 GPA stood first in the Duggirala Mandal In the month of March, 2014 she appeared for 10^{th} class (S.S.C.) Public examination conducted by the Govt., of Andhra Pradesh state. She proved her merit in the examination by securing the highest grade of marks in the entire Duggirala mandal where GRETNALTES school is located. Coming from a Leprosy colony and born to leprosy affected parents, life was not easy for Suneetha. She had to face lots of challenges.

Suneetha is from a poor family. She dreams to become a Medical Doctor. Her aim is to render service to the downtrodden people in the society particularly the leprosy community.
